Food and Drug Council executive board reelected by acclamation

FDC President Paul Kenny pledges further growth and achievement

Los Angeles (March 17, 2011) — Affiliates of the Food and Drug Council voted unanimously to reelect the current FDC executive board to a new term. The vote took place at the FDC's March 16 membership meeting at the Millennium Biltmore Hotel in Los Angeles.



Before the vote, several affiliate leaders stood up and praised the achievements of FDC President Paul A. Kenny and the other members of the executive board, which has transformed the organization from a Southern California-based Labor think tank into a powerful coalition that spans nine states, encompassing seven unions and representing more than 375,000 affiliate members.

Kenny commemorated the reelection with announcements of recent successes by the FDC, including the successful conclusion of a five-year campaign to organize workers at Alta Dena's City of Industry, Calif., dairy plant. This victory makes the major dairies in Southern California one hundred percent unionized, he noted.

"We plan to expand the FDC to more states and bring the fight directly to those who try to take union rights away from people who have earned them through years of struggle and service," Kenny said.
